The abstract should be prepared in A4-size (210 x 297mm) in Microsoft Word and should not extend one page including references. Line spacing should be 1.5 lines in Times New Roman font with size of 11, in an area no more than 20 cm high x 13 cm wide. The title should be in 19pt bold, uppercase and center aligned.
